AER Update: Steve Harrington

The AER is still experiencing a lot of changes, currently in phase II of transitioning. Steve shared a pamphlet on "How to Register a Private Surface Agreement" that he thinks can be helpful and clarify a few questions. As per the following information:

Industry Updates:

Questfire Energy Corp: Ted Thompson

In the next two months no wells, pipelines or work overs are planned in the area.

Scollard Energy Ltd: Trevor Krauss

Scollard Energy has recently signed a surface lease at 4-14-46-2 W5 south of the existing Questfire 4-14-46-2 W5 surface lease. This lease has been discussed previously with the BLWSG in 2012. Scollard will be working with Kingsmere Resources to use this surface lease to drill a Hz Cardium Oil well with a bottom hole target at 1-10-46-2 W5. The well is not yet licenced and notifications will be sent out in the next few weeks.

Kingsmere Resources Ltd: Myles Aiken: As per Dennis Miller

13-10-46-2W5 (1-9 surface)-

- Gas line tie in completed and placed on line January 2.
- Waiting on Fortis line construction to complete electrification of pump jack engine.

1-10-46-2W5 (4-14 surface)

- New well scheduled for drilling in March in partnership with Scollard.
- Surface lease negotiated by Scollard last year. Well is in tier one lands and is the location settled on after reviewing alternatives with nearby stakeholders.
- Anticipate issuing D 56 notifications late next week.
- Cardium horizontal similar to 13-10. Similar facilities anticipated with tie in of solution gas once the nitrogen has cleaned up from the frac.

BonaVista Energy: Eleanor Vokes/Billy Joe Waldo

Still in talks with landowners in Battle Lake area.

14-10-46-2W5M surface, application non routine for 13-15 and 15-15 BH

Michael Black commented-standing objection from the Battle Lake Natural Area Preservation Society.

04-27-045-02W5M surface, 04-34-045-02W5M BH Drilling rig on

03/04-15-042-04W5M surface, 4-14-42-4 Drilling rig on

15-27-45-28W4M removing old compressor station equipment and replacing with new equipment which will include 9390 Waukesha compressor.

Pipeline construction from 04-15-42-4W5M lease starting this week.

County of Wetaskiwin: Kathy Rooyackers

Open to questions. Applying in 2015 to do work on the Battle Lake Trail.

County concern regarding Industries heavy and frequent loads on the County roads. Frequent phone calls from residents. Discussion ensued: Industry to be diligent about staying off banned roads while fully loaded. Triana Wakelin @ Pennwest shared a scenario of where Industry came together in the past, financially, to help repair roads.

Resourceful Petroleum/ARCIS Seismic Solutions: Ian Baker/John Ropchan

Currently working in the area. East boundary of 3D is on Eastern side of boundary. Sub surface rights. No immediate drilling plans.

Seismic program-120 landowners engaged. Started the beginning of Dec., 2013 and will finish the end of Jan., 2014. Not going into natural area.
