AER Update: Steven Harrington

Industry Updates:

Questfire Energy Corp: Ted Thompson

Inspection of Crystal Pipeline: A helicopter fly over inspection was conducted this past Summer. In October on the same line a walking inspection was completed and we are still evaluating the data collected. In mid-November an internal inspection with a smart pig will be conducted on a portion of the line. The walking inspection on two other short lines, Battle Lake South and Battle Lake North, are on hold until next year due to the snowfall. Landowners along the lines were notified by phone calls or by Xpress mail of the upcoming inspections. Questfire Energy was very appreciative of the positive response by landowners to the inspection.

Scollard: Trevor Krauss/Ken Moen

Scollard is currently pursuing a surface lease at an existing pad site outside of the watershed boundary, no additional land will be disturbed. This is being pursued to drill a Hz Oil well with a bottom hole location at 104/1-30-46-1 W5. The pad site is located at 1-25-46-2 W5 and currently has two existing wells on the site. Scollard is proposing to drill this well at the end of November through early December. The well will be completed mid-December if timing allows if not it will be completed in the new year.

Acquiring a surface lease at 4-14-46-2W5 to drill a horizontal sweet cardium well to 1-10-46-2W5. The 4-14 surface will be adjacent to an existing Questfire surface lease.

Shared activity locations on Tier 1 map.

Kingsmere:Dennis Miller

Pipeline construction. – Currently awaiting final approval from Conoco for tie in of solution gas from 13-10-46-2 to Conoco 3-9-well. Expect to initiate construction within the next 2 weeks.

Participating with Scollard in drilling 1-30-41W5 from existing surface lease in 1-25-46-2. If successful well will be tied in to the 8-25 battery.

Plan to recomplete and test well 14-30-46-1 as a water injection well. Work to be carried out in late November.

Other:

Evaluating a new drill, 1-10 or 4-11-46-2 from a surface in 4-14 adjacent to existing Penn West surface location.
