#### FOLLOW UP:

Financials – Bank balance Feb.23/2015 was \$9412.36. Several more company memberships have been received but there are also several outstanding bills.

Murray Ormberg suggested that if money is tight that we should consider eliminating the meal and landowners donate cake/cookies/squares for dessert. Consensus to leave as the status quo right now. We will also try and keep the cost of our open house down.

- Vanessa Cartwright is resigning as treasurer as she will not be working effective the end of June 2015. Moved by Eleanor Vokes and seconded by Betty Reimer that Jill Salus be our new treasurer and signing authority will have to be changed for our bank account at the ATB in Rimbey with the addition of Jill Salus and deletion of Vanessa Cartwright. Update Synergy Alberta – Rick Anderson has reviewed the website for our synergy group. Rick Anderson took part in a conference call by phone and computer where Synergy Alberta showed how to get to difference areas on the AER website such as daily compliance and monthly reports. This was suggested as a possible topic for our May meeting.

### Update Synergy Alberta cont.

PRESENTATION /DISCUSSION - Shaun Richer and Chris Proudlock gave a power point presentation from Red Core, who is a privately owned pipeline company from Sylvan Lake which started in 2007. They have approx. 300 employees. They do pipeline construction and development, shut downs, turnarounds, custom projects and fabrication of separator buildings. They discussed the benefits of pipelines versus rail and tanker trucks. A question and answer period followed.

### DISCUSSION ITEMS

Spring information session/open house – To be planned for first part of June 2015 with BBQ followed by presentations. If we can not have an orphan well presentation, reclamation and remediation was suggested. Another suggestion was the Justice Department and Property Rights Advocate.

## **RRSG Written Member Updates for March 2015**

Additional member updates were provided verbally at the meeting.

### **Bonavista**

- We currently have 1 drilling rig at 14-26-41-5W5M Gilby area.
- Most wells and facilities will be down for minor maintenance and turnarounds when Keyera Rimbey is down from April 25<sup>th</sup> to about May 13<sup>th</sup>
- Minor service work on wells through area.

### **Keyera**

At the Rimbey Plant:

- Turbo project continuing
- Started the fraction de-bottleneck project (allowing Keyera to make more propane)
- Turnaround planned for the Rimbey Plant, will be shut-in April 26 – May 13. Associated with the turnaround, there will be increased traffic. At peak times we are expecting 650 people on site.

### **ConocoPhillips**

- Staff reductions of 7% taking place this week
- Reduced activity in area, no drilling in Central Alberta planned for 2015 now looking forward to 2016.
