RRSG Written Member Updates for May 2015

Additional member updates were provided verbally at the meeting.

ConocoPhillips

No drilling activity planned for remainder of 2015. Layoffs in the Calgary office announced and in progress.

Keyera

The Rimbey/Gilby Emergency Response Manual is currently being updated - H2Safety is doing the area resident consultations as required for this update.

Keyera is finishing up a 1200 meter pipeline from 1-6-44-1 W5M into the Rimbey Gas Plant

Starting the construction phase for the Wilson Creek Pipeline extension project - affected landowners have been signed up and all regulatory work has been completed. Project has been hampered with recent wet weather.

Noise survey is being conducted at the Rimbey Gas Plant on September 23rd & 24th with the addition of the Turbo Expander and associated equipment that has been added to the plant's process area.

On Oct 6/15, Keyera is hosting a BBQ for the Grand Opening of the Turbo Project at the Plant. There will be Keyera and all levels of Government dignitaries in attendance and Keyera would like to extend the invitation to all members of the Rimbey Regional Synergy Group.

Lacombe County

Harvest season – watch for traffic

50% ban being placed on Gimlet Road (RR 4-3) due to the poor condition of the road. Lacombe County has the first 3 miles of road as you head north off o Hwy 12.

Drilling / Completions: 2-32-42-3 (2 well pad), 16-15-42-3 (single drill)

Pipelines: 2-32 (on lease tie-in), 16-15 to 2-22-42-3 (250m tie-in)
2-26-42-3 (remediation ongoing due to 'pinhole' leak in pipeline)

Operations: business as usual

Maybe some new drilling in Q1, 2016.

Ponoka County

450 miles of gravelling completed.

Paving complete on 5 miles of Iola Road, Hamlet of Bluffton 2 blocks and 1 mile of access road.

Rr 40 second lift of chip seal on 4 miles completed,

Calcium on 200 residences this year and 12 residences took oil for dust control.

Tamarack Valley

1 drilling rig active

Facility construction – pipeline and wellsite
