ACTIVITY UPDATES

Imperial: Normal operations at Imperial Oil Wilson Creek field. No rigs in area.

Wilson Creek Gas Plant is being planned for site decommissioning.

<u>Alberta Energy Regulator (AER, formerly ERCB):</u> new board and commissioners listed on website.

Now all pipeline incidents and others that affect public safety will be made public online.

Bonavista:

Drilling: Westerose 01-35-45-28W4 is to be spudded July 4th/2013

Currently have a drilling rig at 3-32-40-6W5 Willesden Green area. Should

be done in approximately 7 days. Then completions will move on.

Drilling two new drills in Sec 23-43-4w5 Rimbey area.

Drilling continuing with 2 rigs running through out the summer in the RRSG

area.

Completions, Construction, Service work: 1-26-41-6W5 (one well) – on lease tie in Willesden Green area; 15-27-40-6W5 (2 well pad) – pipeline to 16-27 header Willesden Green area; 15-22-41-5W5 well site facility Willesden Green area; 4-10-41-4W5 (one well) – pipeline to 15-18-41-4W5 Gimlet area; 15-18-41-4W5 (one well) – pipeline to 4-19-41-4W5 Gimlet area; 16-23-43-3W5 pipeline construction Westerose area.

Also construction group will be discontinuing and abandoning certain pipelines in the area throughout summer and fall.

Inline testing at 15-21-41-4W5 Gimlet area Pad until June 23rd. Then construction will be doing facility work for approximately 7 days.

Doing lease and pipeline cleanups in the area as weather permits through out area this will continue through the summer.

Building a lease at 1-33-42-4w5

Service rig in Westerose, Hoadly and Willesden Green areas, service work <u>Suncor</u>: rig completions 44-5 end of June. Pipeline crews same area. No drilling planned for August, September. Road to battery on Iola Road and the north construction. Theft issues, specifically construction. Precautionary shut-ins of many pipelines with river crossings during heavy rain/high water levels. Redcore: waiting for rain to stop.
